

JOINT RESOLUTION  
SCHOOL BOARD AND CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, full utilization of existing public facilities, programs, and services is a desirable community goal; and

WHEREAS, there is a limited amount of tax monies and other human and physical resources available to meet public demand for facilities, programs, and services; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the public officials to improve the quality of life of all citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Kerrville Independent School District has facilities, equipment, and a staff organized for the purpose of providing educational opportunities for children and certain other social cultural, educational, and recreational activities for all district patrons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kerrville provides facilities, staff, and certain recreational and service programs for the citizens within its geographical boundaries; and

WHEREAS, a number of other related public and private community organizations provide programs and services for community betterment; and

WHEREAS, no single, cohesive strategy for the development and utilization of all these relevant community resources has yet been established; and

WHEREAS, there are great potential social and economic benefits to be derived from further cooperation in facility and program development for the benefit of all citizens through the Community School program;




TO endorse, support and encourage the concept and development of a Community School program in Kerrville.
