

Prepayment Policy

All reduced and full paid students are able to pre-pay for their lunches. A check or cash can be sent in with the student to their school and/or prepayments can be made online at the Child Nutrition page of the Kerrville ISD website by setting up an account and using a credit card to pay for transactions. A small transaction fee is incurred with this option.

Cash or checks can be sent to the cafeteria at your school at any time with your child to give to the cashier in his or her school cafeteria. Please make checks payable to "Kerrville ISD Child Nutrition Services". Please write the child's name and the student ID# on the bottom left hand side of the check.

Note: a fee will be charged for all returned checks. If checks are returned from the bank, check privileges will be terminated for the remainder of the school year.

Prepayments can also be made during the lunch time by giving payment to the cashier or kitchen manager.

All monies are deposited into your child's account upon receipt.

In the Elementary Schools and the Secondary Schools the money in your child's account can be used for meals or Ala Carte purchases.

The breakfast price for Elementary school students is \$1.50 for paid students and \$0.30 for reduced. The lunch price for Elementary school students is \$2.25 for paid students and \$0.40 for reduced students. The breakfast price for Secondary school students is \$1.50 for paid students and \$0.30 for reduced. The lunch price for Secondary students is \$2.50 and \$0.40 for reduced students.

If you wish to have your child use his or her money only for meals and not for ala carte purchases, please specify that on the check or in a note with cash payment. Please, do not mix cafeteria payments and payments to other school functions/departments.
