




plan no later than February 4, 2002, but the Board's target date for adoption is OCTOBER, 2001.

4. Plans should redistrict the entire school district. The Board, of course, will be considering the effect of any plan on the entire school district. Also, Kerrville Independent School District is subject to the Voting Rights Act, which protects various racial and language minorities. Thus, as a matter of federal law, the Board will be required to consider the effect of any proposal on multiple racial and ethnic groups. If a plan does not redistrict the entire school district, it may be impossible for the Board to assess its impact on one or more protected minority groups.
5. Plans should conform to the criteria the Board will be using in drawing the trustee districts.
