Resolution

A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Kerrville Independent School District to Sell Real Property

WHEREAS, some interest has been shown by a commercial developer in this property, and

WHEREAS, this property is currently used for overflow parking, an excellent competition baseball stadium, an excellent softball stadium, and event parking, and

WHEREAS, there is a tremendous investment by this community through the athletic booster club to upgrade and develop these competition facilities.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOGNIZED that, if property is sold, relocation and replacement of these facilities must be made with better facilities than currently exist.

IT IS FURTHER RECOGNIZED that the student use of these facilities dictates the requirement that timing of the replacement be such that no play season is completed without home fields. The District intends to retain possession of and access to the baseball stadium through the 2001-2002 season.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH BOARD POLICY CDB (LEGAL), as derived from Education Code 11.154, the Board hereby authorizes the advertisement for bids on property generally described as approximately 20.5 acres adjacent to the current Tivy High School between the power lines and the funeral home from Sidney Baker Street to the Scott Schreiner Golf Course.
