WHEREAS, the Kerrville I. S. D. Board of Trustees has on this date discussed and considered the proposed revisions to the Texas Education Code released by Commissioner of Education Lionel Meno,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kerrville Independent School District Board of Trustees hereby opposes any changes in legislation which would remove from the locally elected School Board the authority to hire and/or dismiss contract personnel,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Kerrville Independent School District Board of Trustees hereby also opposes any changes in legislation which would establish hearing examiners appointed by the Texas Education Commissioner to conduct hearings in cases of dismissal, nonrenewal, or return to probationary contracts,


BE IT ALSO FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Kerrville Independent School District Board of Trustees hereby opposes any increase in the number of either staff development days or instructional days if the resulting increase in costs are not funded at the state level,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Kerrville Independent School District Board of Trustees hereby opposes any changes in the Education Code that would reduce the authority of the locally elected School Board.
