Resolution


WHEREAS, that upon this date the duly elected Board of Trustees of the Kerrville Independent School District met in a public meeting with a quorum present and did consider the stated intention of Eckerd Youth Alternatives (EYA) to establish a Texas Youth Corrections (TYC) facility in collaboration with Kerr County;


WHEREAS, the Kerrville Independent School District has been notified that other youth services providers, in addition to Eckerd Youth Alternatives (EYA), have submitted or plan to submit proposals to the Texas Youth Corrections (TYC) for the establishment of a residential facility in Kerr County;

And WHEREAS, the Kerrville Independent School District has determined that there are financial, educational, and various other hardships such a residential facility could potentially pose for our community;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Kerrville Independent School District cannot support any endeavor that seeks to establish, in the Kerr County Juvenile Detention Center, a Texas Youth Corrections (TYC) facility in collaboration with Kerr County if that endeavor utilizes the Kerrville Independent School District as the educational services provider.
