Wade Ivy Selected to Serve as KISD Interim Superintendent

KERRVILLE, TEXAS (August 3, 2016) – The KISD Board of Trustees convened in a special meeting on Monday, August 1, and selected Wade Ivy as Interim Superintendent upon the resignation of Dan Troxell, Ph.D.

Ivy has served in various positions in KISD since 1995 as teacher, assistant principal, principal, and currently holds the position of Assistant Superintendent for KISD. Mr. Ivy received his Superintendent Certification through Lamar University.

“I feel confident that Mr. Ivy will successfully lead Kerrville ISD during this time of transition,” Dan Troxell, Ph.D., said. “He has proven himself to be dedicated to our schools and community and has done an outstanding job in each position he has held.”

After accepting the position of KISD Assistant Superintendent in 2012, Mr. Ivy has developed processes for successful recruiting and hiring and implemented the annual KISD job fair. Additionally, Ivy ensured the Antler Stadium Renovation Project was completed on time, within budget and met the expectations of the community.

“I am honored to be selected by the Board of Trustees to be the interim superintendent as they seek a permanent replacement. I look forward to working with the Board and the Kerrville ISD faculty and staff to ensure we continue to provide an excellent educational experience to our students,” Wade Ivy said.

Ivy will lead the district during the time that the Board of Trustees will conduct the Superintendent search process this Fall. It was stated by the Board that the Interim Superintendent cannot apply for the position of Superintendent.
